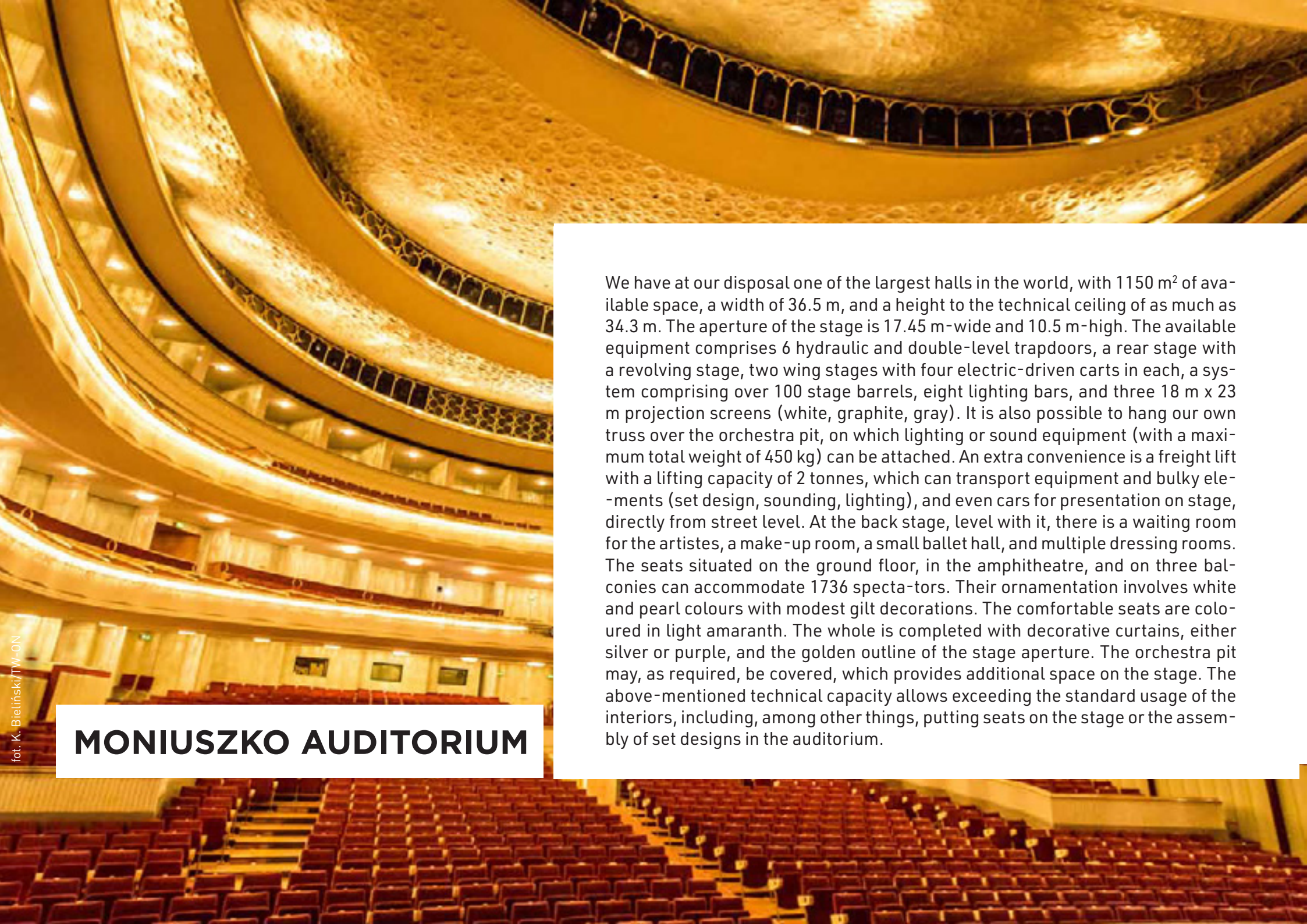
The Teatr Wielki - Polish National Opera offers a broad range of artistic activity, cultivating, therefore, its tradition spanning over more than 200 years; it stages productions from a diverse opera and ballet repertoire, master-pieces by Polish and foreign composers, world classics, and pieces by contemporary authors.

A small but significant part of the theatre's activity involves the organisation of external events focussed on political, scientific, and medical issues, as well as culture and entertainment. On many occasions, including our jubilee celebrations and other special events, we had a chance to have as our guests companies and institutions such as the Business Centre Club, Polish Market, Polish Television, Polsat, TVN, BPH Bank, Sal Oppenheim, "Teraz Polska" Foundation, "Polityka" Passports, the SAR Marketing Communication Association, the Polish Brotherhood of Guttenberg Knights, Kino Świat, and Forum Film Poland.

Our smaller and more intimate rooms have hosted multiple conferences, scientific symposia, fashion shows, thematic workshops, jubilee celebrations, galas, and many other events organised by the National Bank of Poland, the Polish Security Printing Works, the Polish Society of Allergology, KGHM Polska Miedź, HiPP, the Adam Mickiewicz Institute, and the TDR Fashion Studio, to name but a few.

It is in our stylish interiors, and with our services, including musical settings, that these companies decided to receive and honour their guests. The list of events is long and varied. The wide spectrum of the theatre's capacity, plus the reliability and professionalism on the one hand, and respect for our potential partners on the other, all constitute the essence of a mutual and successful cooperation.

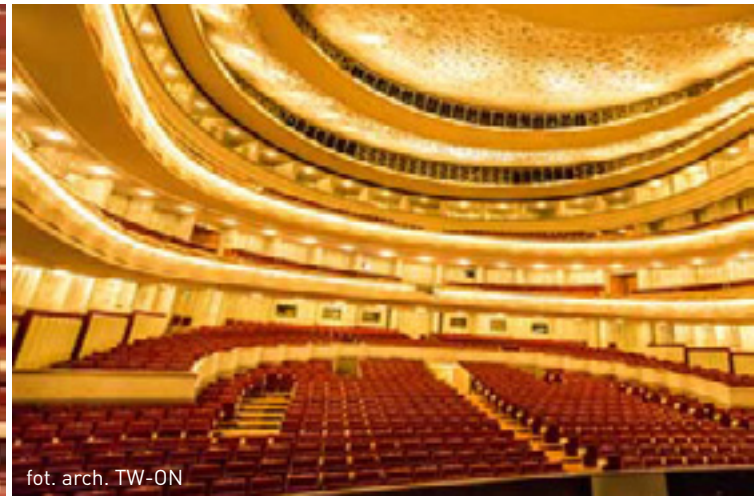
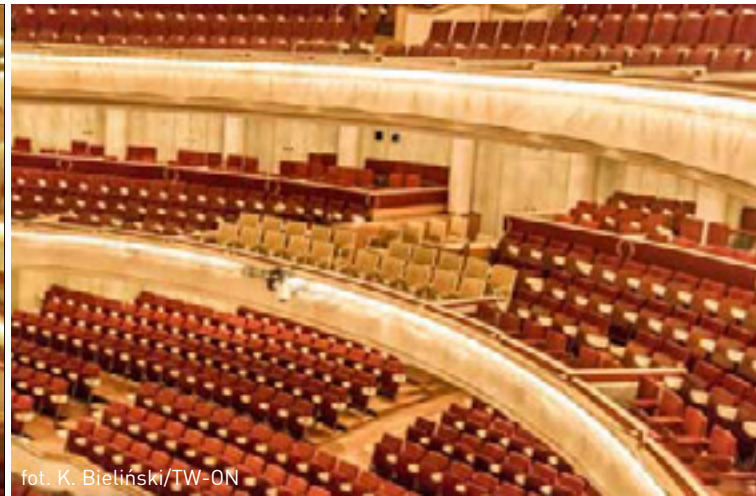
We have at our disposal one of the largest halls in the world, with 1150 m² of available space, a width of 36.5 m, and a height to the technical ceiling of as much as 34.3 m. The aperture of the stage is 17.45 m-wide and 10.5 m-high. The available equipment comprises 6 hydraulic and double-level trapdoors, a rear stage with a revolving stage, two wing stages with four electric-driven carts in each, a system comprising over 100 stage barrels, eight lighting bars, and three 18 m x 23 m projection screens (white, graphite, gray). It is also possible to hang our own truss over the orchestra pit, on which lighting or sound equipment (with a maximum total weight of 450 kg) can be attached. An extra convenience is a freight lift with a lifting capacity of 2 tonnes, which can transport equipment and bulky elements (set design, sounding, lighting), and even cars for presentation on stage, directly from street level. At the back stage, level with it, there is a waiting room for the artistes, a make-up room, a small ballet hall, and multiple dressing rooms. The seats situated on the ground floor, in the amphitheatre, and on three balconies can accommodate 1736 spectators. Their ornamentation involves white and pearl colours with modest gilt decorations. The comfortable seats are coloured in light amaranth. The whole is completed with decorative curtains, either silver or purple, and the golden outline of the stage aperture. The orchestra pit may, as required, be covered, which provides additional space on the stage. The above-mentioned technical capacity allows exceeding the standard usage of the interiors, including, among other things, putting seats on the stage or the assembly of set designs in the auditorium.

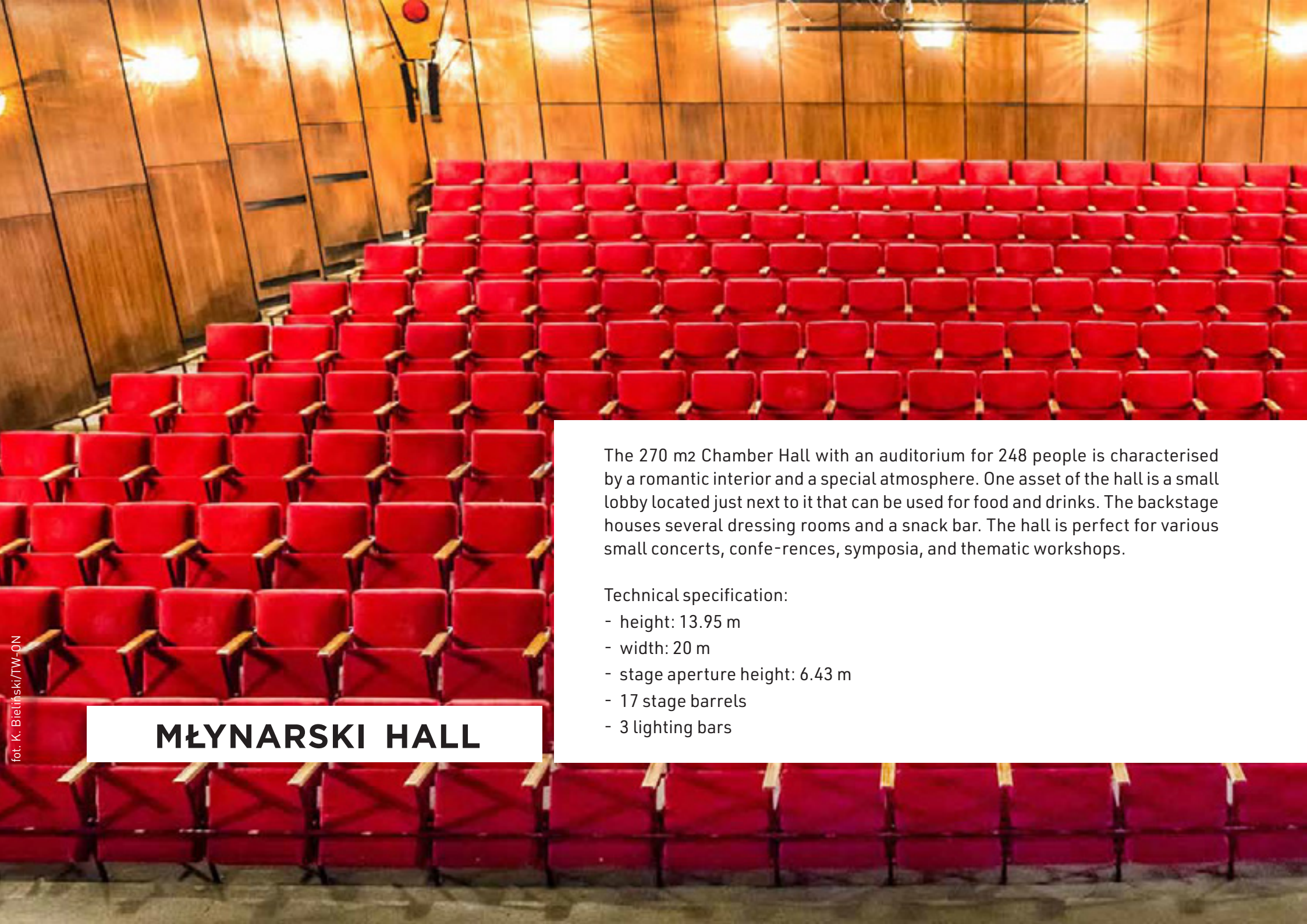

The 270 m² Chamber Hall with an auditorium for 248 people is characterised by a romantic interior and a special atmosphere. One asset of the hall is a small lobby located just next to it that can be used for food and drinks. The backstage houses several dressing rooms and a snack bar. The hall is perfect for various small concerts, conferences, symposia, and thematic workshops.

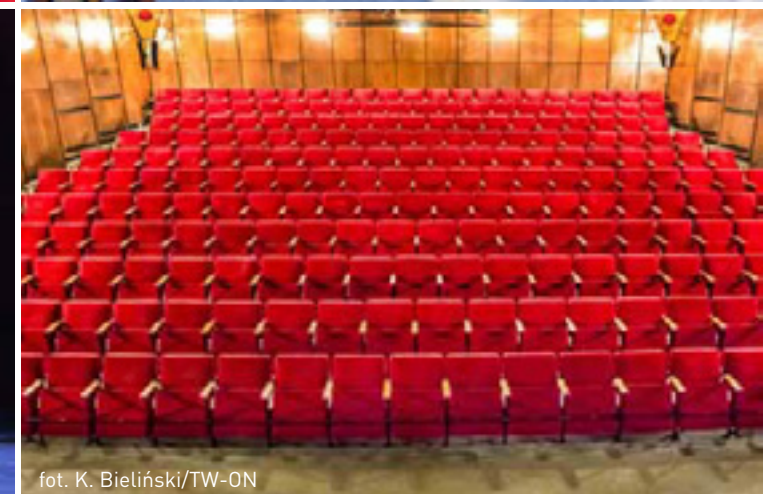

The Redutowe Rooms are former museum halls, the only place in the theatre where the original decor by Antonio Corazzi has been preserved. Their specific, T-like shape, facilitates dividing them into three sections with purple curtains (which can also be drawn or taken off completely). The interiors, characterised by excellent acoustics, are surrounded by professionally-lit decorative galleries. The rooms are equipped with a suspended screen and chairs for the easy arrangement of the auditorium. There is also the possibility of erecting a stage. Aesthetically pleasing white walls and columns, and wooden flooring, form the perfect basis for arranging these beautiful interiors to embody different styles, as the situation and needs require.

The 8.22 m high Redutowe Rooms, with its 540 m² floor, can accommodate:

- 400 persons in concert arrangement
- 320 persons in dinner arrangement
- 600 persons in banquet arrangement

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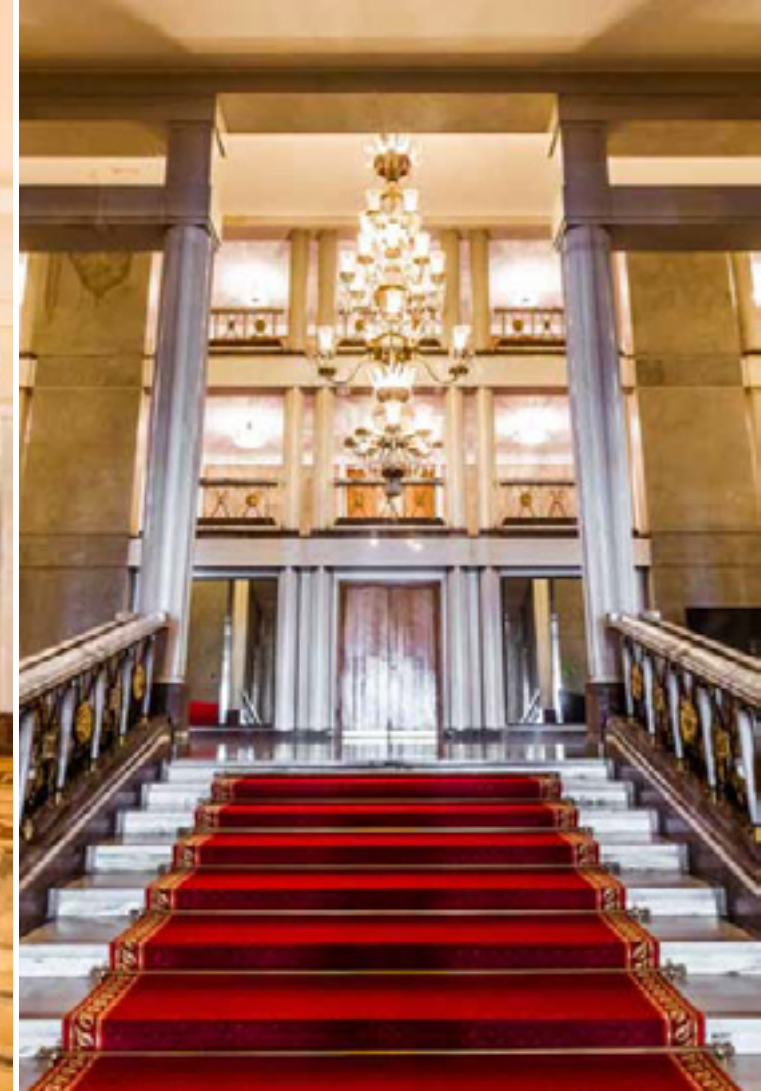


THE MAIN FOYER

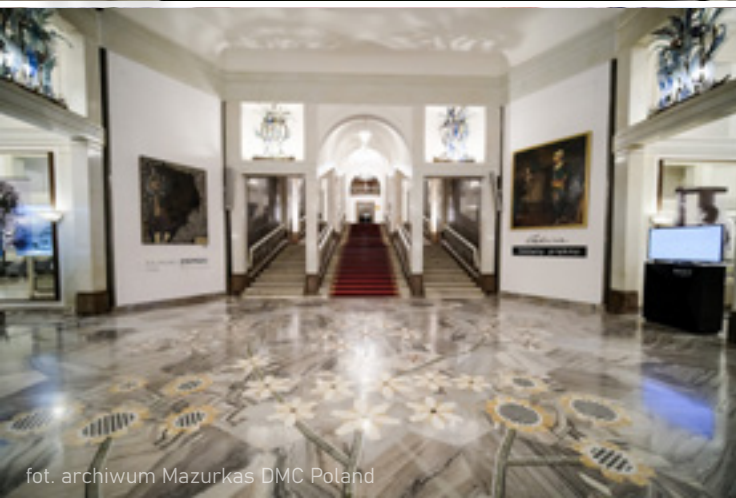
A spacious lobby with an area of approx. 860 m² is located at the level of the theatre's first floor, in the place of the former Emperor's Box, with direct exit to the terrace. It serves as a venue for formal receptions after performances, but small concerts and various meetings are also organised there. Its special ornaments are the marble floors, stucco walls, pillars, crystal candelabra, and large chandeliers.

The large interiors allow the organisation of a variety of events, including:

- banquets for 1700 guests,
- dinners for 700 guests,
- fashion shows,
- conferences,
- scientific symposiums.

THE MAIN TERRACE

The Main Terrace, measuring 132 m², with a beautiful view of Teatralny Square and the renovated Jabłonowski Palace, is directly adjacent to the Main Lobby. It constitutes additional space to be used for events organised in the theatre and is perfect for small and original meetings in the spring-summer season.
